

PREMIERY fair in the hands of youth

For one whole day, young farmers will become hosts of the Polagra-Premiery International Trade Fair of Agricultural Mechanisation. Symbolic keys to the MTP will be handed over to them on the European Young Farmers Day on 12 February 2010.

A delegation of several hundred young farmers from a number of European Union countries, Poland included, will gather together in Poznań to take part in the plenary session of the European Council of Young Farmers (CEJA). The session will be chaired by CEJA President Joris Baecke. The event will be one of the most prominent items on the agenda of Polagra-PREMIERY and European Young Farmers Day. Co-organisers include Rural Youth Union (ZMW) and Trade Union National Centre of Young Farmers (ZZCNMR).

The session will be accompanied by a number of meetings of young people with advisors and the announcement of winners in the competition held to select "The Most Innovative Young Farmer 2009" organised by the National Council of Agricultural Chambers.

The third edition of Polagra-PREMIERY will take place under the honorary auspices of the Minister of Agriculture and Rural Development. The fair will begin on 11 February and last four days. The organisers estimate that the exposition prepared by exhibitors will be attended by more than 60,000 professional visitors.
